#### A letter from Acting Head Pastor Bo Mircea

### 1 Thessalonians 4:13-14

13 Brothers and sisters, we do not want you to be uninformed about those who sleep in death, so that you do not grieve like the rest of mankind, who have no hope. 14 For we believe that Jesus died and rose again, and so we believe that God will bring with Jesus those who have fallen asleep in him.

Hope, beyond this life! If you are to look into the history of human kind, this idea of "there is more to life than what we see here" comes up time and time again, and in so many different ways. For some cultures it goes to reincarnation, to some it comes to crossing the Styx River from the realm of life to the realm of death. Of course the conversation sometimes goes to a place with nothing, that nothing happens after we die. And yet, the Christian Faith comes to speak about life everlasting, about a time to come where God will call His creation home. And maybe for some of us this conversation is as fuzzy as those new slippers you got Grandma for Christmas last year. Nothing new under the sun, I will add. The same questions that we have today were present in Paul's life. And he tried to address them a few times in his writings. One of the things that he does make clear is this: If you believe in Jesus, his death, and his resurrection, then you have to believe that there is something more to come. And that is hope. That is comfort. That is peace.

I pray that as we share the word of comfort on Sunday, God will give us strength for the things that are going on in our lives, and things that, at times, create a lot of anxiety, fear, and doubt. Pray for faith to spring forth from this coming Sunday.

I look forward to worshipping with you as we celebrate the goodness of the Lord together.
