A letter from Acting Head Pastor Bo Mircea

Jonah 2:1-2
Then Jonah prayed to the Lord his God from the belly of the fish, saying,

"I called to the Lord out of my distress, and he answered me; out of the belly of Sheol I cried, and you heard my voice."

You know what I realized recently? I do not think I have ever preached on Jonah. I know that over the years I have talked about it, during Sunday School or VBS with the kids, but never in a sermon. If I really think about it I do not remember hearing too many sermons on Jonah. To make things short, this is a fascinating story about real human emotions and responses to the different situations that we experience as people of faith, when our humanity puts us at odds with God. I know we associate the story with the big fish, but the realism of the struggle of obeying God is the real star of the show. I would encourage you to read the story of Jonah, it is a short read. As you are thinking about Jonah may I suggest a question for you to ask yourself? Here is the question: Am I a Jonah?
