### A Letter from Lead Pastor Bo Mircea

Well Folks IT IS HAPPENING! In my long/short history being here at 1st Pres, I cannot remember canceling Midweek two weeks in a row!!! I am not sure how I feel about it, but I know that it will help keep some of you folks safe and warm.

What I really want to talk to you about today is Pastoral Care. The part of every church ministry that goes out and loves and cares for the people in our community and sometimes provides a listening ear, a prayer, sometimes a meal, or even more practical help. As people of faith we come with the understanding that our shared experience as we go through life, is there to encourage, to edify and build up not just our faith, but our whole community. I recall a time when hospitals would call the church to let us know that Grandma Ethel (not a real character in this story) is in the hospital and she would love a pastor's visit. Not long after that we had to call the hospital with a code to check on our people. And today we are at the point where it is almost impossible to find out who is where, if the family or friends do not share that information with the church. And maybe in a way that is good, because it forces us to reach out, to include our friends in our lives even when that means we are going to let someone know that we need some love and care.

I guess in a nutshell, I am sharing with you a very simple and powerful encouragement that has helped the church over and over again: Your church, your friends will love and care for you if you let them share in the blessing of ministering to you.

Pray, laugh, cry, rejoice, empathize, and serve with your village. Because the more you do the better your village grows.

This week, our church family is going through a tough time. We're saying goodbye to a couple of people who've been with us for ages. On Saturday, February 15th, from 9 am to 10 am, and at 10 am we'll have a visitation and a service to remember Sheila Lundeen. And on Monday, February 17th, from 9 am to 10 am, we'll remember Klint DeGeus. I'd love for you to join the families and help us remember, grieve, and find hope in God's promises as we gather for a time of remembrance.
